What is Women's Impact Fund?

- Women's Impact Fund is a diverse group of more than **420 women** coming together to effect change.
- Women's Impact Fund has funded **59 grants**, totaling **over \$4.6 million**, since its inception.
- Grants are given to Mecklenburg County non-profits in **five** focus areas: **arts & culture, education, environment, health, and human services.**

How does it work?

- Women's Impact Fund utilizes a collective giving model in which like-minded women pool their charitable contributions, research critical community needs, and decide as a group where to give grants. Giving together magnifies the power of philanthropy and enriches the philanthropic experience.
- Women's Impact Fund is dedicated to creating a membership of educated philanthropists who will understand the community's emerging issues and become informed, experienced grant-makers.
- Women's Impact fund hosts several philanthropy education and social events each year to bring members together for networking and enrichment opportunities.

How did it start?

- Claire Tate and Mary Lou Babb, two of Charlotte's philanthropic all-stars, started Women's Impact Fund in 2003. After recruiting 158 first-time members, Women's Impact Fund awarded its first grants in June 2004.

What's happening in 2016?
